Key Elements of Disciple-Making How to Create a Movement



The right seed in the right ground will multiply and bear fruit—thirty, sixty, and a hundredfold. But it is only when we do the Word that it begins to grow. If we only listen and do not act, we deceive ourselves, and there will be little growth or transformation. If we stop doing, the seed will soon stop growing or die, and there will be no fruit.







- "Did you speak this Sunday?"


He replies, "Yes."

We have Bible schools, conferences, and countless meetings. We go to church Sunday after Sunday, listening, but for most, it ends with only knowledge and little transformation.

Knowledge is important, but I often say: It is still better to know less and obey it than to know more and do nothing with it.




There are two kinds of people here: both hear the Word, but only one is transformed. The difference is NOT in the hearing—it's in the doing.

James 1:22-25 (NIV)

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.

But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.

There are always two kinds of people when it comes to the Word of God. Both may hear the same message, sit in the same room, and listen to the same teaching, yet only one is truly transformed. The difference is never in the hearing—it's in the doing. Hearing without obedience leaves us unchanged, but hearing with action leads to real transformation and fruit.



Build Your House on the Rock [Matthew 7:24-27]

- 24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and **puts** them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.
- 25 The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.
- 26 But everyone who hears these words of mine and **does not put them into practice** is like a foolish man who built his house on sand.

 27 The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.

Let me ask you a challenging question.

Let's say I have a person coming into the church who doesn't know the Gospel and needs freedom and deliverance. He is ready to repent and receive the Holy Spirit, but he doesn't understand the Gospel yet.

How many in your church could you ask, "Hey, can you take this person, sit down with them, share the gospel, lead him to repentance, baptize him in water, and help him receive the Holy Spirit and freedom?"

Luk 6:40 The disciple is not above his master: but every one who is fully trained will be like their master.....



Luke 10:2-4

He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves.

Luke 22:35-36

Then Jesus asked them, "When I sent you without purse, bag or sandals, did you lack anything?" "Nothing," they answered. He said to them, "But now if you have a purse, take it, and also a bag; and if you don't have a sword, sell your cloak and buy one.

As leaders in the church, we need to move from teaching only to discipleship and take people through all these steps:

Step One: Teach them how to...

Step Two: Show them how to...

Step Three: Let them do it with someone...

Step Four: Let them do it alone...

Step Five: Let them show others how to do it.






