
1. The Real Purpose of the Five-Fold Ministry – and common misunderstandings.











Ephesians 4:11-13

- 11 So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers,
- 12 to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up
- 13 until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.











Ephesians 4:14-16

- 14 Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming.
- 15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.
- **16** From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.











- Christ gave the gifts not a human idea. (Christ is all of these; together we are His body, and He is the head.)
- To equip the saints not for a few to perform while others watch, but to activate everyone.
- Until we all reach unity in the faith these gifts bring the Body together in unity in the faith.
- For maturity so we are no longer infants tossed around by false teaching. (Each gift is meant to mature us in a unique way.)
- From Christ the whole body grows joined and held together, as each person does their part. (Everyone is called to ministry.)











The reason IS:

- To equip the saints for ministry.
- To build up the Body of Christ.
- To help believers reach unity and maturity.

The reason for these gifts is NOT:

- To have a title or platform.
- To create an untouchable "super-Christian" image.
- To have a ministry with lots of money.











Some Misunderstandings

- You are first and foremost a disciple of Christ.
- You don't need to be one your whole life.
- Not everyone is one of these.
- Some are 80% one and 20% another.
- They are all for today.
- Apostle is not the highest and most important.
- They are functions, not a position.


2. The Five-Fold in the Light of the Whole Series – how each gift connects with the key lessons.











The Five-Fold in the Light of the Whole Series

- •The Seed Teachers provide the right seed (the Word); Evangelists sow the seed and equip the workers.
- •The Ground Prophets point out what needs to change, keeping the focus on God's kingdom rather than this world.
- •Doers of the Word Evangelists lead people out to the streets, helping them become doers of the Word.
- •The Spiritual Level Evangelists bring people to new birth; Shepherds care for the newborn; Teachers provide the right food; Prophets cultivate relationship with the Father; Apostles give vision and bring it all together.


3. Everyone Carries Some of This DNA – these gifts are not only for leaders, but for the whole body.













We begin as infants, growing as disciples of Christ. As we mature, we recognize our specific giftings and step into them more and more, bearing much fruit and helping to equip the rest of the body to walk as disciples of Christ.




Which one of the five-fold ministry gifts am I?






If I ask someone sitting in the chair of an evangelist,

They would answer: "To seek and save the lost. People are going to hell, and we must be out there preaching the gospel so people can encounter God. That is why the church exists!"




If I ask someone sitting in the chair of a pastor (shepherd),

They would answer: "We need to care for one another. There are people in the church who are hurting and in pain. We must love one another, help one another, and build each other up."



If I ask someone sitting in the chair of a teacher,

They would answer: "We need sound doctrine. It is the truth that sets us free. Many are dying spiritually because they lack God's Word. We must return to Scripture."



If I ask someone sitting in the chair of a prophet,

They would answer: "We need to hear from God. We need to listen to His voice. We are so busy with church activities that we forget the most important thing — to be with Him."


4. Strengths and Weaknesses – the plus and minus of each gift, and why no gift should stand alone.











If a pastor is strong in one gift but lacking others, the church will reflect that imbalance.

- We need all five gifts operating.
- Together, as Christ's Body, we manifest the fullness of His ministry.
- Leaders should identify who has which gifts in the church and build together accordingly.











When You Enter a Church/Ministry Led by a Strong Evangelist

Plus:

- · A lot of outreach and focus on the lost.
- · Many new believers being born again.
- The Word goes far beyond the church walls.




Minus:

- · People often come in one door and leave through the back door.
- · Lack of biblical foundation and discipleship leads to weak spiritual growth.
- · Over time, people leave frustrated or stop growing in their calling—reduced to simply watching the evangelist do his ministry.

When You Enter a Church/Ministry Led by a Strong Shepherd

Plus:

- · You feel welcome right away—like being part of a loving family.
- · Atmosphere of grace, care, and belonging.




Minus:

- · Little outreach because of fear of the "wolves" outside.
- Few new believers—mostly Christians coming from other churches.
- · Limited spiritual growth—people remain spiritual infants, not challenged to step out beyond the church walls.

When You Enter a Church/Ministry Led by a Strong Teacher

Plus:

- Deep knowledge of the Word, with solid doctrine and a strong foundation.
- · Few fall away because the Word takes deep root in people's lives.



Minus:

- · People become hearers only, not doers.
- · Knowledge increases, but there is little life, testimony, or action.
- · Growth often comes from other churches seeking good teaching, not from reaching the lost.

When You Enter a Church/Ministry Led by a Strong prophet:

Plus:

- · Strong emphasis on seeking God's presence.
- · High value placed on prayer, fasting, and hearing God's voice.




Minus:

- · Can sometimes appear strange or weird to outsiders.
- · Often lack biblical discernment, which can become unhealthy ("God told me..." without foundation).
- · Little fruit in terms of new people coming to Christ or believers maturing in their faith.


The church will be a place where many new believers are born again and welcomed into a family full of love and care. They will truly belong and grow in the Word, standing on a strong foundation. With a clear emphasis on God's presence—through prayer, fasting, and hearing His voice—the Word will take deep root in them, and few will fall away. In a short time, they will mature and become spiritual parents and grandparents in the faith, as a movement begins and continues to spread and multiply. The focus will remain on God, on reaching the one, discipling the three, equipping the twelve, empowering the 120, and carrying the mission to the ends of the earth.


5. The Apostolic Gift – when everything comes together in vision, foundation, and multiplication.











The apostle can step into the other functions, but his strength is building beyond the local church—taking responsibility for cities, nations, and beyond. He thinks in terms of churches, not just one church; nations, not just one nation. With a vision for multiplication on a larger scale, he travels from place to place, imparting apostolic DNA, equipping people, and then moving on to the next mission.






Follow Christ and grow up in Him to maturity. Over time, you will begin to see more and more what your gift is. When you do, be free to become the best of what God has created you to be—because we need you to be exactly who He made you to be.











Pastors and Leaders




6. Other Gifts in the Body – recognizing that we need all the gifts to function together.

- Let people grow by stepping into their call you grow into it over time.






